CHECKLIST



Let The Village Diaper Bank know about your drive! We can help you promote your drive and speak to your group.



Pick a location – find a convenient spot for people to drop off diapers and label collection area with colorful signage. You can also decide to go virtual and create an online drive <u>here</u>.



Decide on a time frame – consider a fun theme or timing your drive with a another event (i.e. holiday giving, Diaper Need Awareness Week, etc.)



Set a goal – goals motivate people to get & stay engaged in your cause. Check in with the DCDB to see what sizes we're most in need of. Develop a way to track your progress (use our chart!).



Announce your diaper drive - via social media, emails, local news outlets, and notices throughout your community. Distribute the diaper need fact sheets in this toolkit. Be active before AND during the drive



Collect diapers and dollars – keep your group updated on your goal progress!



Share your results! – Post pictures on social media and let everyone know how well you did. Don't forget to thank donors & volunteers too.



Deliver the goods – coordinate a diaper drive drop off with The Village Diaper Bank. Make sure you have a large enough vehicle to handle the haul! If you host an online drive, product will be delivered directly to The Village!



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Hosting a drive with a few friends, coworkers, or family members helps minimize the workload by spreading responsibilities across a team and helps spread the word, too! Assemble your dream team, make a plan, and get started!

Themes

Choosing a theme for your diaper drive helps it stand out! Tried and true themes like "Moms Helping Moms" or Stuff the Bus/Squad have been both popular and successful, but feel free to think creatively to come up with your own ideas too!

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Our mission is to eradicate diaper need to improve the physical, mental, and economic health of the families we serve.

What is Graper Need?

Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient supply of diapers to keep an infant clean, dry, and healthy. The struggle to afford diapers can lead to serious physical and mental health problems for both babies and parents.

Babies require up to 12 diapers per day, and toddlers need ~8 on average.

Need by the Nymbers

- 1 in 3 families struggle to afford an adequate supply of diapers
- 5,000 children in Dane County live below the Federal Poverty Line (FPL)
- \$75 = average monthly cost of diapers per child
- 0% of diaper needs are covered by government assistance programs (SNAP & WIC)

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DID YOU KNOW...

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Most childcare centers, even free or subsidized facilities, require parents to provide a daily supply of diapers. Without diapers, children can't attend daycare meaning many parents and caregivers are forced to miss work or school too.

Health Impacts

- Ρ
- H Diaper rash (more severe, Y longer lasting)
- S Urinary tract issues
 - Increased risk of infections
- A Infant irritability & increased crying

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- Children's brains build the foundation for attachment, trust, and emotional maturity at just a few weeks old – the stress of being left in a dirty diaper can permanently alter their brains.
- Prolonged crying linked to instances of abuse
- Low self esteem, depression & anxiety in parents

- Missed work/school for parents further limiting economic opportunities
- N Families cut back on other basic necessities, like food & utilities
 - Increased medical costs due to frequent infections

A diaper bank is a nonprofit group that collects, buys, stores, and distributes free diapers to homeless shelters, food pantries, family service agencies and faith-based organizations.

- 52 million diapers were distributed by diaper banks in 2016
